WHAT IS THE TEAM CHALLENGE?

- The main presentation you will perform at your tournament. Most of your preparation will focus on this.
- Time limit of 8 minutes, starting from the "launch area."

 Integrates elements outlined in the challenge document. Aim to have a beginning, middle, and end to your story.
- Can include two "Team Choice Elements." These are "extras" in your presentation that can showcase special interests or talents of your team. They can't duplicate something required by the challenge.
- This should be done as much as possible by your team members, to prepare them for the "No Interference" policy.



WHAT IS THE INSTANT CHALLENGE?

A short (usually 5 minutes or less), "surprise" challenge that teaches think-on-your-feet cooperation and problem-solving. It's performed on Tournament Day for the appraisers.

Performance-based

Team members will get a prompt for performing a skit. They will be given a few minutes to plan before they present to the appraisers.

Task-based

Team members will have to design and build something (a tower, for example) with the supplies provided.

Combination


As the name implies, the challenge will have both building and performance components.

STARRY SHOWCASE FORM

Explains your Team Challenge to the appraisers so they know what to expect in your performance. Gets filled out and submitted online before the tournament. Your Regional Director will be in touch with you about this closer to tournament day.
