The Sheikh Faisal Bin Qassim Al Thani Museum is a treasure trove of Islamic art, Qatari heritage, vintage vehicles, handmade carpets, and rare coins, from four continents. Each piece weaves together the personal journey of Sheikh Faisal and the rich tapestry of global history.



Museum of Islamic Art

On a purpose-built island abutting the Corniche, Doha's waterfront promenade, the museum is home to masterpieces of Islamic art, collected from three continents. The lush MIA park next to the museum overlooks the Arabian sea, and is a favourite spot for picnics, walking, running or outdoor yoga classes



Katara Culture Village
